THE CHALLENGE

The Federation is a sprawling, multi-entity nonprofit encompassing a family of social service agencies with different needs and utilizations, which makes financial planning and reporting a tricky process. Despite those complex needs, the Federation got by for a long time without budgeting software, instead making do with piecemeal, manual processes. The team needed a tool that could streamline and automate analog tasks, freeing up time, speeding workflow, and enabling greater mental energy.



THE SOLUTION

Only one modern budgeting tool felt like a match for the Federation's unique specifications: Solver's extended financial planning and analysis (xFP&A) solutions. "Solver was the only service that looked like it would meet our reporting and budgeting needs," said Devorah Miller, the Associated's ERP finance project manager.

The Federation integrated its existing ERP, Sage Intacct, with Solver's platform, then relied on Solver's implementation partner RSM to build out a customized environment complete with budget templates, reporting tools, and data structures specific to the organization and each of its entities.

How has Solver improved critical business processes?

The Solver Suite has been transformative for the Federation, modernizing and streamlining its financial planning operations. "Solver took us from budgeting in separate Excel files to being able to collaborate with department heads and different entities on budgets," said Miller. By embracing Solver's robust xFP&A solution, the Federation has gone from an outdated, siloed budgeting approach to a modern system that boosts collaboration and increases productivity.



What key benefits have you seen since implementing Solver?

Solver has saved the Associated time. "The entire budget process has been sped up," said Miller. "Consolidated financial statements are now able to be run in one report—and run very fast." That functionality allows the Federation's executives to review financial data in whatever form they need it, whenever they need it, with no manual number-crunching required.

How does the Associated plan to grow its xFP&A capabilities with Solver?

Right now, finance heads from the Federation's member agencies take advantage of Solver's xFP&A resources. Soon, however, the organization plans to roll out the technology to other department heads, paving the way for greater intra-organization communication, cooperation, and productivity. Miller also sees opportunities for further automation of key processes, template customization, and expansion of reporting dashboards. "We're really excited to launch it to all of our department heads," she said.
